To encourage students to become active, compassionate, and lifelong learners.

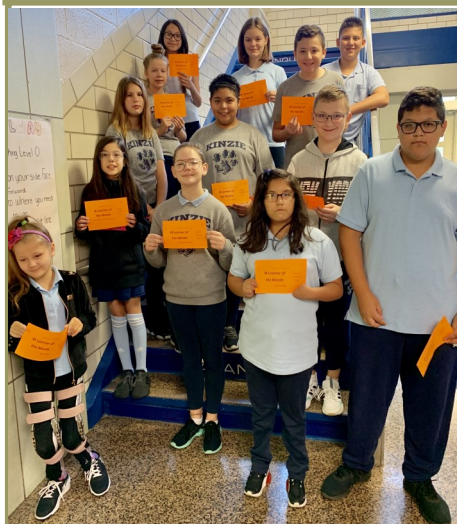
To create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.
