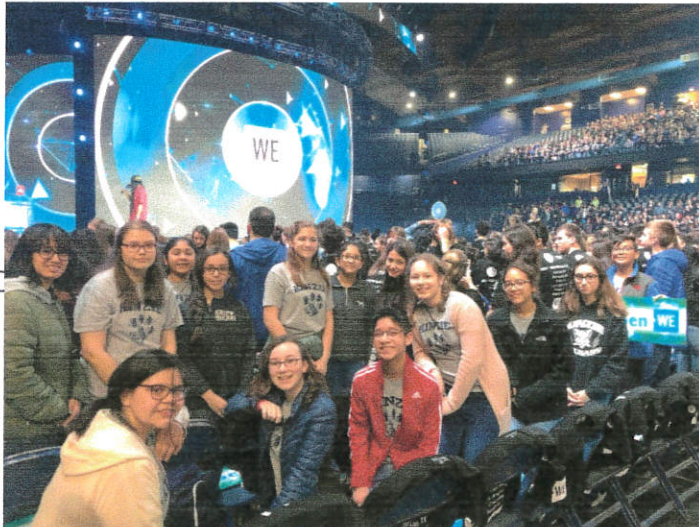
Community Service
